



PROPOSED PROVINCIAL / TERRITORIAL ROTATIONAL CO-CHAIR CYCLE

A rotating co-chair cycle will be established to provide, transparency, predictability and foresight to provinces and territories (PT) regarding responsibility for co-chairing the FPT Infrastructure governance tables. During each co-chair term, the appointed PTs will assume the co-chair responsibilities at the three senior tables, including: the table of Ministers of Infrastructure, the Deputy Ministers' Steering Committee and the Senior Officials' Committee. Working Groups may be co-chaired separately.

Co-chair responsibilities will be assumed for a period of 1-year within a fiscal period (April to March). Although every PT will make best efforts to assume their role as co-chair for the designated year, PTs may request to trade with other PTs, on consensus between the two parties or may decline to participate. Every effort has been made to respect geographical balance.
